APPELLATION

Rueda DO

ELABORATION

Grape reception at the cellar. Crushing and destemming and gentle pressing to extract free-run juice, common cold settling followed by alcoholic fermentation during 30 days at 14°C.

PAIRING

Rice dishes with fish, seafood and sushi, avocado and shrimp, bagel with smoked salmon, boiled lobster. Meat or tuna tartar

TASTING NOTES

Honest and expressive white wine, made entirely from Verdejo grapes harvested at peak ripeness. Aromas of pear, apple, and a touch of fennel and stone fruit emerge; fresh palate, with medium body, a clean finish, and the delicate bitterness of Verdejo.
