### GRAPE VARIETY

100% Tempranillo.

### ALCOHOL %

### TERROIR

Age: More than 60 years old.

Soil: Limestone.

Altitude (m): 820.

Sustainable farming.

Hand harvested in 15 kg crates.

### VINIFICATION

Hand-picked in 15 kg. crates. Taken to the winery by refrigerated trucks. The bunches are sorted on a sorting table. After destemming, the berries are sorted on a second sorting table. Cold soak. Alcoholic fermentation in 30 hl. Vats. Malolactic fermentation in French oak barrels.

### AGING

12 months in French oak barrels and 12 months in 15 hl. French oak foudre.

### PAIRING

Perfect for game and red meats, roasted vegetables and meats, lamb chops, foie grass, mature cheese.
