97% Tempranillo, 3% Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot.

TERROIR

Age: More than 80 years old.

Soil: Clay and decomposed granite.

Altitude (m): 800-1000.

Sustainable farming.

Hand harvested.

VINIFICATION

Exhaustive grape selection both manually and through an optical selector. Each parcel is vinified separately in 24 different vats using the force of gravity. Fermented by indigenous yeasts and minimizing the presence of oxygen. Barrel aged in new extra-fine French oak barrels (20%)

AGING

Aged 11 months in extra-fine grain French oak barrels.

PAIRING

Ideal for grilled red meats, stews, lamb and small game. Elegant dishes as braised beef cannelloni.

TASTING NOTES

Fresh, elegant, tense wine. 10% of the wine has been aged in ovoid polymer tanks; which contributes to the final assemblage aromas of red and floral fruits, perfumed and elegant, with a lively, concentrated mouth, with fresh nuances and pure flavors. It is a modern wine, from high altitude vineyards, with a continental climate, with an amazing final balance.
